Our LinkUp support groups are for individuals and their families who want to explore and overcome the challenges of living with hearing loss.

Finding help for hearing loss

We know how daunting it can be when you experience changes in your hearing.

It can leave you with feelings of uncertainty, isolation and anxiety about the next steps you should take. You may also feel overwhelmed when looking for support that works for your personal needs.

That's why Hearing Link Services, which is part of the Charity Hearing Dogs for Deaf People, offer LinkUp support groups.

These are free groups that have been designed by people with lived experience and understanding of hearing loss, for other people going through the same challenges.

Our LinkUps are delivered in-person for groups of up to 15 people. They are held in a residential setting and usually take place over a weekend. Communication support is provided so you can participate fully.

The aim of our groups is simple.

LinkUps are a chance to explore the challenges of living with hearing loss, share solutions and find out about technology or equipment that can make life a little bit easier for you or a loved one.




LinkUp support groups

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Frequently asked questions

It's normal to feel apprehensive about meeting new people, even more so when you have a hearing loss. You might ask:



Below, we answer some of the questions we are frequently asked to help put you at ease about joining one of our groups:

• Q: Who can apply for a LinkUp support group?

A: Our groups are for people with all levels of hearing loss. We also encourage a partner, family member or friend to join you on the journey, as we understand that hearing loss affects your close personal relationships too.

Q: Where in the UK are LinkUp support groups held?

A: They are offered in every country of the UK. After registering your interest, we will locate the closest one to you, at the earliest convenient date. Our groups are extremely popular so you may be offered a place in a

different part of the UK, or added to our waiting list until a place is available nearer to you.

Q: How long does a LinkUp support group last?

A: Our groups take place over a weekend (Friday until Sunday) in a residential setting, usually in a hotel.

Q: Who delivers the sessions?

A: Each session is led by Hearing Link Services peer support volunteers or members of staff who have lived experience and understanding of hearing loss. We cover important and useful topics such as communication strategies, lipreading and technology.

Q: I worry I won't hear everything. How will I be able to keep up with what's being said?

A: LinkUp support groups are fully accessible. We provide speech-to-text-reporting (STTR) where every word that is said is typed on a large screen. We also provide a good working hearing loop.

A BSL interpreter can be made available on request.
